FARMER-led SIDE EVENT

"AU - EU partnership and the role of FOs in Resilient food systems and sustainable agri value chains".

The African Union - European Union Agriculture Ministers Conference 30 June 2023, FAO HQ, Rome, Italy 12:30 – 14:30

The Africa-EU Partnership, with its continental approach, is an instrument of political dialogue and cooperation, overarching and complementing existing development relationship frameworks between EU and African countries.

In the framework of the fifth African Union - European Union Agriculture Ministerial Conference in Rome (Italy), <u>PAFO</u> is on the lead, with the support of <u>Agricord</u>, of a farmer-led side event, to showcase the role and value addition by African Farmers Organizations and Agri-Agencies operating in partnership.

The main objective of the session is to undertake a stocktaking of the key contributions and main achievements of the joint program: The Farmers' Organizations for Africa, Caribbean and Pacific (FO4ACP) program (FO4ACP) and "Farmers Organizations Leading Research & Innovation on agroecology for sustainable food systems" FORI) in strengthening the capacities of farmer's organizations and promoting sustainable rural development.

Under the Rural Transformation Agenda signed in 2019, strengthening Farmers Organizations and Farmers' Capacities and Promoting Sustainable Rural Development were key components of the action agenda.

In this context, Farmers Organizations have been strongly advocating to increase the incomes and improve livelihoods, food and nutrition security and safety of organized smallholders and family farmers in Africa by strengthening regional, national, and local farmer's organizations. This is how the **Farmers Organizations for Africa, Caribbean and Pacific (FO4ACP) program** was initiated (2019-2024) and its peer programs in Asia and Latin America. The emphasis is on economic services, advocacy, and institutional development of the membership-based farmers' organizations in order to strengthen the cooperation between African and European farmers. Similarly, to ensure the peer-to-peer approach, which has proven to be an effective way to work on many environmental, business development and financial sustainability topics. Organizations Leading Research & Innovation on agroecology for sustainable food systems (FO-RI, 2022-2026). The purpose of this program is to foster a transition towards resilient, productive and sustainable agro-ecological food systems through farmer-led innovation and research.

The **FARMER SIDE EVENT**, **led by PAFO**, is on "AU - EU partnership and the role of FOs in Resilient food systems and sustainable agri- value chains" . The session is organised into three discussion blocks focus on:

- i) Keynote presentation on the role of Farmers Organisations in building resilient food systems and sustainable value chains.
- ii) Showcasing success stories of economic services of member-based farmers organizations.
- iii) A panel discussion on Agroecology practices and soil health maintenance for agricultural productivity.

The Farmers' Organizations for Africa, Caribbean and Pacific (FO4ACP) program aims to increase the incomes and improve the livelihoods, food and nutrition security, and safety of organized smallholders and family farmers in African, Caribbean and Pacific countries by strengthening regional, national and local farmers' organizations. The program is implemented by six regional farmers' organizations, PAFO, Agricord and the FAO Regional Office for Latin America and the Caribbean. They work closely with the national FOs, agri-agencies and sub-implementing partners in about 70 countries, with a potential outreach of over 52 million smallholder farmers. Great emphasis is put on economic services, advocacy and institutional development of the membership-based FOs.
